 - CMB physics

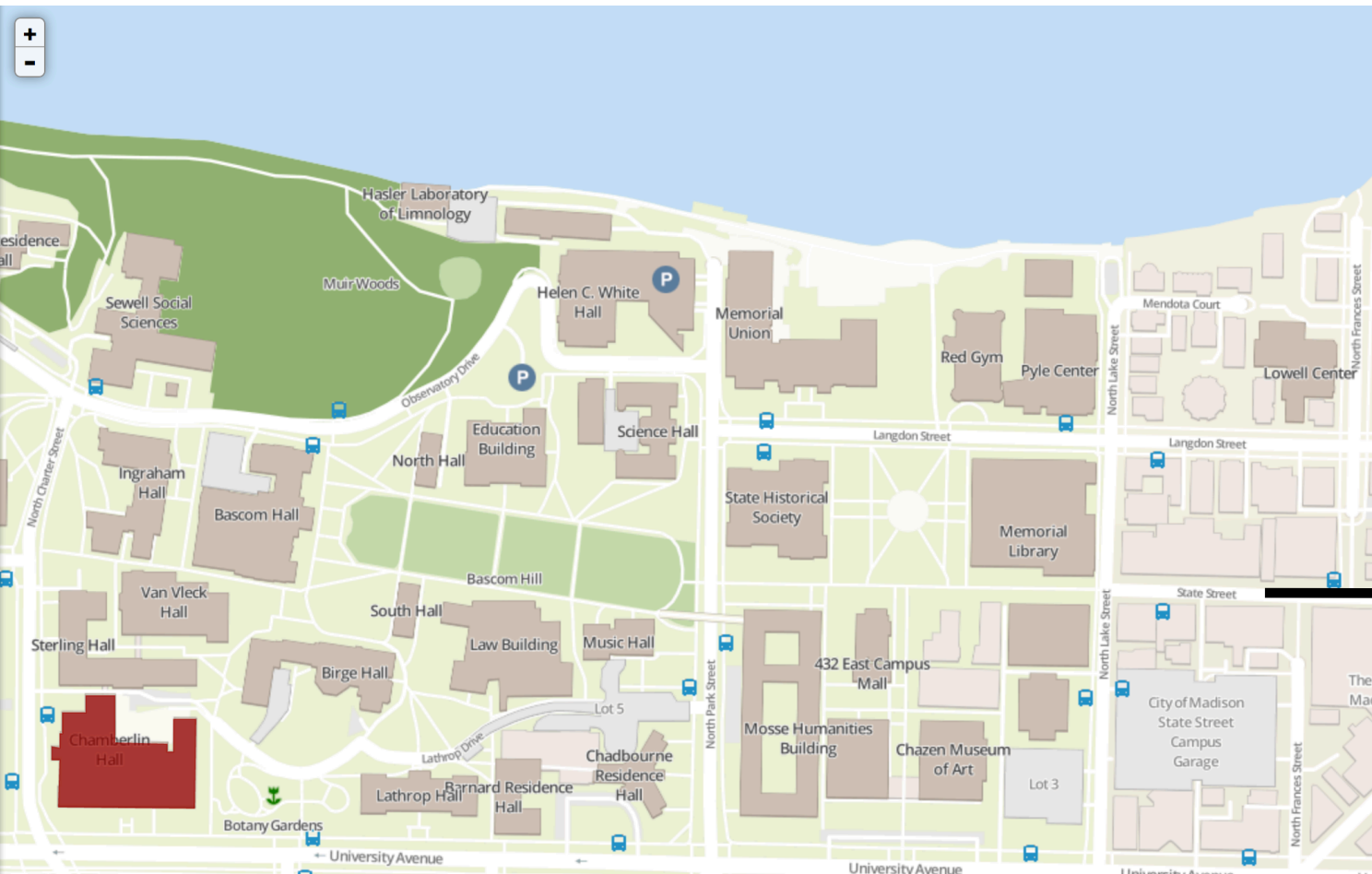
MBI 2016

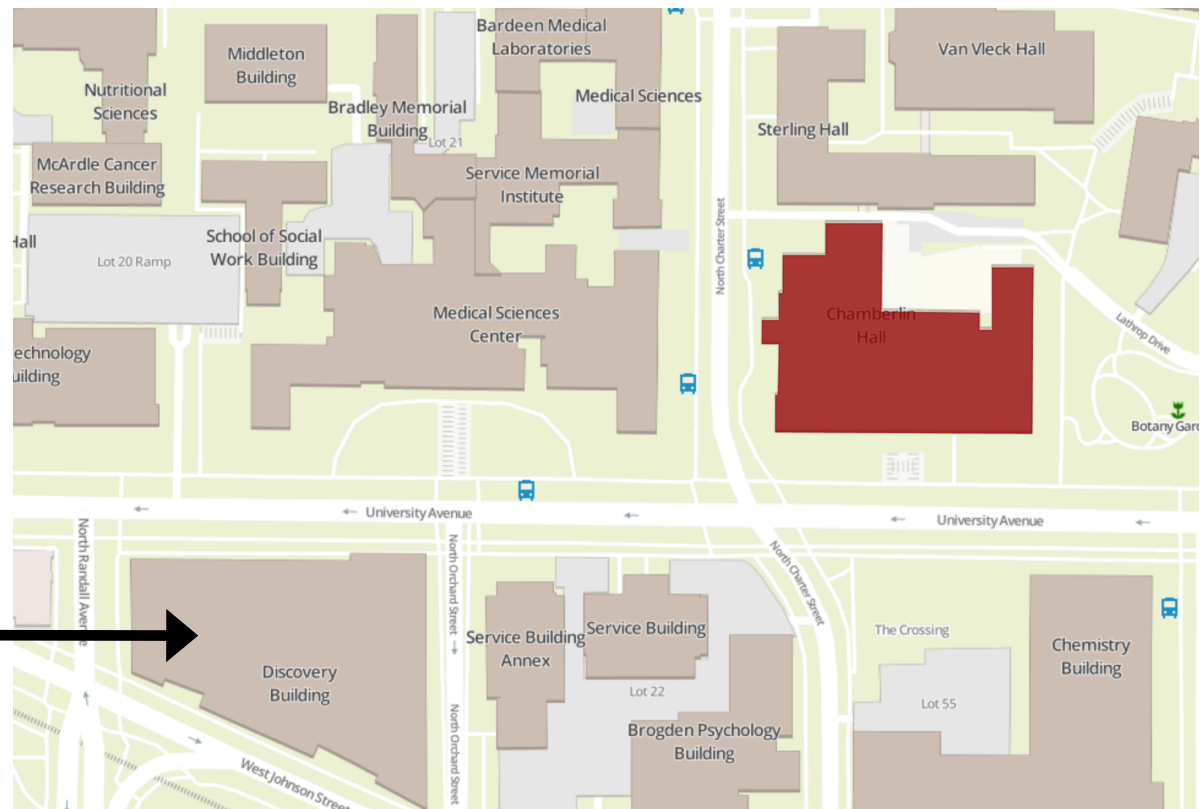

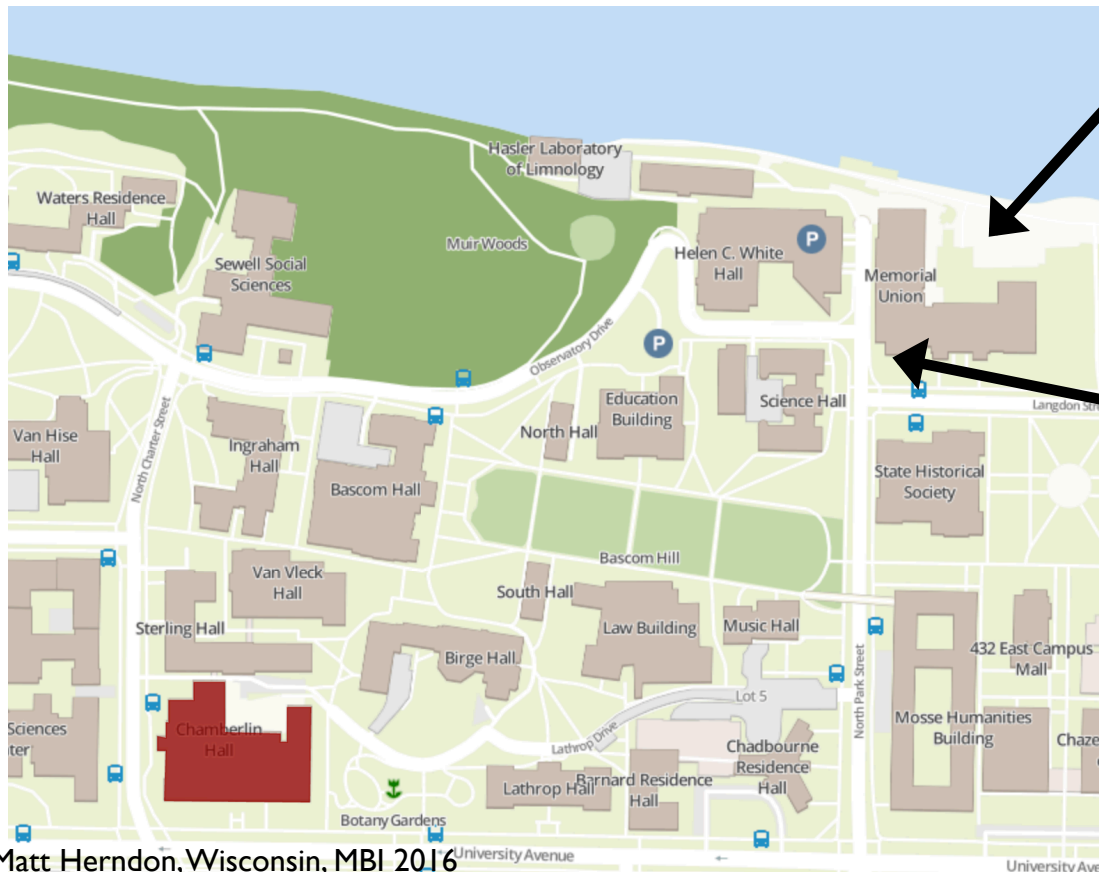
